## Douro – Quinta da Trovisca 1999

Quinta da Trovisca 1999 is a wine originating in the vineyards from which it takes its name, and it is distinctive for its excellent freshness, which is unusual in old wines like this.

## Tasting Notes

Color: ruby

Flavor: ripe fruit, and an oak nuance that combines well with a smoothness that is the result of its excellent development in bottle.

In the mouth it is fresh, with nice velvet tannins and a balanced acidity.

Ready for enjoying, or for a few more years' ageing.

## Elaboration

Totally destemmed grapes, followed by a slow fermentation with temperature control up to 86 °F degrees during 25 days. Soft filtration. Bottled in August 2001 after ageing 6 months in French oak barrels.

## Varietals

Touriga Nacional (30%), Touriga Franca (25%), Tinta Roriz (15%) Tinto Cão (5%), Tinta Barroca (5%), Others (20%).
